

## **Assessments for all LEP Students in 2006-2007**

**LEP:** Students in BE/ESL with Parent Permission and Students with Parent Denial

### **State: Accountability for LEP Grades 3-12**

**Rating:** Exemplary, Recognized, Academically Acceptable, Academically Unacceptable

**Tests:** Measures how well students are learning grade level content in the core subjects.

**TAKS** in English (3-12) and Spanish (3-6 only) in Reading/ELA, Writing, Math, Science, Social Studies

**TAKS-I, SDAA II**

**TAKS LEP Exemption:** Grades 3-10 TAKS

- A possible three year LEP-Exemption for **qualifying** LEP in Bilingual/ESL Program
- No TAKS LEP-Exemption allowed for LEP with Parent Denial

**TAKS LEP Postponement:** Grades 11-12 Exit Level TAKS

- A one time postponement for LEP students that have been in U.S. schools for less than 12 months from date of first TAKS administration.

### **Federal: Accountability for LEP in Grades K-12**

**Ratings: 1. AMAOs – Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs) K-12**  
(Met AMAOs or did not meet AMAOs)

**Tests:** Measures how well students are learning the English language.

**TELPAS-** Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System Texas

**TOP-** Texas Observation Protocol

Grades K-2 Rated on L, S, R, W

Grades 3-12 Rated on L, S, W

**RPTE-** Reading Proficiency Tests in English

Grade 2-12- RPTE

**2. AYP- (Adequate Yearly Progress) for LEP in Grades 3-8 and 10**

(Met AYP or Did not Meet AYP)

**Tests:** Measures how well students are learning grade level reading and math.

**TAKS** Reading in English or Spanish for LEP without Exemption

**RPTE** for LEP Exempt

**TAKS** Math for LEP without Exemption

**LAT** TAKS Math- Linguistic Accommodated Testing for LEP Exempt

**TAKS-I, SDAAII, LDAA**

**Federal Guidelines for AYP:** Requires 95 percent participation

LEP- 1<sup>st</sup> year immigrants count for Participation

LEP- 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year immigrants count for both Participation and Performance
