CSCOPE

5 Big E's

Become familiar with the components of the 5E Instructional Model from the view of an administrator, teacher and student.

CSCOPE Content Roll Outs *NEW*

Need time to prepare for your upcoming six weeks in CSCOPE? We will review purposeful planning using CSCOPE. Teachers will have time and materials available to prepare for use in their classrooms. Sessions are led by content area specialists.

CSCOPE Foundations

This session provides participants with the basic information to be successful in implementation of the curriculum. The training session is designed for teachers who are entering a CSCOPE district as well as teachers from districts that are new to CSCOPE. Training will focus on the theoretical underpinnings of the curriculum and the use of CSCOPE documents.

CSCOPE for Your Mamas and Papas *NEW*

If your district is new to CSCOPE, it is new to your parents too! Use the tools and tips in this session to provide parents with an understanding of the CSCOPE curriculum. Great ideas for Curriculum Nights will be shared!

CSCOPE Science Revised TEKS/Vertical Alignment Training for Administrators *NEW*

This session is designed for administrators and curriculum leaders interested in the implementation of the newly revised Science Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills for 2010/2011. The session will provide critical information regarding the effective implementation of the TEKS within the CSCOPE classroom, including the principal's role as instructional leader for science instruction. Participants will examine revised Vertical Alignment Documents and Instructional Focus Documents and learn how to support teachers in implementation.

Differentiating Instruction in the CSCOPE Classroom

Participants will benefit from indepth focus on CSCOPE curriculum and methods for differentiating for special populations in the regular classroom.

Mini Assessments Using WebCCAT *NEW*

Assessments must be aligned to the scope and sequence or Instructional Focus Document to maximize student success. Learn what elements make up a valid mini-assessment and how to build the assessment using WebCCAT. (Bring S&S or IFD from one content area/grade level)

WebCCAT is turning 10 years old and as a present we've given it a whole new look! During this 3hr session educators will learn new features of WebCCAT, navigate the system and build assessments.

Aware

Aware User Training for Teachers and TOT's *NEW*

These sessions provide participants with the skills to navigate the Aware system. Districts may request two hour sessions focusing on data analysis, the assessment generator and utilization of the forms feature.

Aware Administrators *NEW*

This training is designed for new Aware users.

In this one day session, participants will learn how to navigate the system, view teacher and student data, give local assessments and access student portfolios. While you are learning about the system, you will be able to view and work with your own district or campus data.

Aware Creating Data Views *NEW*

Audience: Central Office Staff, Administrators

Participants will learn how to create custom data views and deploy those to certain users.

Aware Creating District Forms *NEW*

Audience: Central Office Staff, Administrators

Participants will learn to create, edit and deploy custom student forms. Also, learn how to use inventories, journals and the forms community.

Creating and Customizing Forms for BE/ESL Students Using Aware *NEW*

This session will prepare campus and district teams to create customized forms for gathering data used for planning and monitoring student progress. Trainers will assist with preparation of forms and provide strategies for managing data within the Aware system.

Supporting BE/ESL Students in the Classroom through the Aware System *NEW*

Campus and district teams will learn strategies for compiling and using various forms of student assessment data to plan for instruction and monitor progress through the Aware system. Teams will practice ways to effectively document, monitor, and adjust student plans for success.

Documenting RtI (Response to Intervention) through Aware (K-12) *NEW*

This workshop is designed for district and campus personnel who are implementing RtI and looking for ways to streamline the process with consistent forms across the district, using Aware. While this workshop will not “teach” the RtI process, participants will have the opportunity to plan and design documents through the Aware data management system and add efficiency to their RtI process through a reading and language arts lens.

WebCCAT and Aware User Training *NEW*

The best of both worlds! During this 3 hour session educators will learn new features to WebCCAT, navigate the system, build assessments, scan assessments and retrieve student data from Aware.
