Planning for Change: Corrective Action and Alternative Governance

This service offering consists of personalized technical assistance in writing Corrective Action plans or Plans of Alternative Governance for schools in stages 2, 3, 4, or 5 of School Improvement based on AYP results. Activities can include assistance in assembling the writing team, collecting the data, composing and/or editing the plan, and consultation on the implementation of the plan. Follow up includes revising the plan at district and/or TEA request as well as representation at the yearly SIRC site visit.

Private Non Profit Cooperative

Region 10 offers school districts the opportunity to enter into a local arrangement for service to their private non profit schools. In this arrangement, Region 10 will handle all negotiations, fiscal responsibilities and reporting requirements for private non profit schools under the Title I, Part A and Title II, Part A federal programs.

SIRC Site Visit Participation

As a service to schools designated as “in need of improvement”, Region 10 State and Federal Initiatives team members will attend the annual SIRC site visit. Team members are also available to assist campuses in preparing for these site visits.

Title I Shared Services Arrangement

Region 10 offers school districts and charter schools the opportunity to participate in a Shared Service Arrangement for Title I, Part A. In this arrangement, Region 10 acts as the fiscal agent for these monies and offers a unique array of services for the members.
