Child Abuse Awareness *NEW*

This online session is designed to educate school staff to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to child abuse. Its purpose is to empower participants to take responsibility for the safety of school students by understanding child abuse safety guidelines and strategies for intervention and prevention.

Drug and Violence Education: DAVE Training

Drug and Violence Education is an online tool for promoting health and safety among young people. It infuses research-based prevention education into the core and supplemental curricula to provide students with consistent, firm, no-drug-use, no-violence messages in all areas of their education.

Internet Safety *NEW*

This online session will feature leading experts in the field who will discuss the latest statistics, trends and solutions to internet safety for students. Participants will learn the current legal and school policy issues that arise due to the anonymity and widespread use of the Internet outside school property. Participants will gain knowledge, strategies, and resources to combat cyber-bullying, sexting, and other dangers related to navigating the internet in school at home.

Internet Safety: What Parents Need to Know *NEW*

This workshop is designed to introduce safety guidelines and procedures for keeping students safe online. Parents will receive resources and tools to become aware of the risks and rewards of the internet and how to stay connected with children in a changing world of Cyberspace.

OASIS – Online Assemblies for Safety in Schools *NEW*

Student leadership development presentations designed to promote resiliency, social skills, and positive choices among students. Schools will have an opportunity to connect students to online presentations that may be downloaded and shown in classrooms upon demand. Presentations will include: Cyberbullying/Internet Safety, Peer Pressure, Bullying, Say No to Drugs, Character Education, etc.

Raising a Drug-Free Child *NEW*

Parents will discover strategies and tools for communicating and staying connected with students to prevent drug abuse & promote responsible student behavior.

Safe School Survey

Participating districts may use this online service to survey their students, staff and parents on issues related to the promotion and maintenance of a safe school environment. Topics in the survey include student reports of violence, illegal use of alcohol and drugs, theft and their feelings about the relative safety of their school. In addition to the basic question series districts may also customize some questions based

on their specific needs. Unlike years past the survey may be opened for lengthy periods of time to accommodate scheduling and computer access. District and campus reports are made available to school districts at an administrative meeting with the Safe School Survey monitor at Region 10 following completion of the instrument.
