The student will be able to:

- format and Braille a thank you note (3-4 sentences)
- use contracted Braille signs listed below
- use Braille punctuation signs (period, question mark, exclamation mark and comma)
- Braille information from uncontracted Braille or tape
- Braille numbers from 1 to 20 followed by the period (number sentences)
- Braille composition signs – capital sign
- make corrections clearly and cleanly
