



TECHNOLOGY OLYMPICS

SKILLS - CALCULATOR - Level 1

These are the skills needed to achieve the highest rating possible using a calculator of any type.

Level 1:

The student will be able to:

- input numbers from Braille, large type, or taped test (up to three digits by three digits)
- read sign of operation (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division)
- read large type/Braille problems independently
- record answers in print/Braille using decimals (only two digits to the right of the decimal)
- Braille users must use Nemeth
- clear calculator
- compute problems and record answers involving monetary signs (decimals and dollar signs)

- **CALCULATOR**
- **HEADPHONES (IF NECESSARY)**
- **TOOLS TO RECORD ANSWERS**
- **PAPER**
