



TECHNOLOGY OLYMPICS SKILLS - DIGITAL MEDIA ACCESS

These are the skills needed to achieve the highest score possible using a digital media player or software that plays a DAISY formatted digital book on CD. Ribbons will be given for independent set-up of equipment.

The student will be able to:

- Use their own digital media player or laptop with digital media software
- Locate specific page numbers and content on the page to answer questions
- Use a CD book and be able to comprehend 3rd grade material from the CD
- Read in large print or braille at a 3rd grade reading level in order to read questions and write answers in their usual writing mode
- Use functions of the media player or software to jump ahead or back to items, bookmark an item to go back to at a later time and use word and line reading functions
- Be able to access information about a book (i.e. number of pages, chapters, or chapter titles)

You will be **REQUIRED TO PROVIDE** the following materials for the competition:

- **DIGITAL MEDIA PLAYER OR LAPTOP WITH SOFTWARE, WHICHEVER THE STUDENT USUALLY USES**
- **BRAILLE PAPER, BOLD LINE PAPER, OR REGULAR PAPER AND WRITING INSTRUMENTS OR EQUIPMENT NORMALLY USED BY THE STUDENT FOR RECORDING ANSWERS**
- **EARPHONES FOR DIGITAL PLAYER OR LAPTOP**
- **TAPE RECORDER AND EARPLUGS/HEADPHONES IF TAPED TEST REQUESTED**
