## Eligibility Requirements

- Master's degree
- 3 years successful teaching experience
- Criminal history review

Meeting eligibility requirements does not guarantee an interview or acceptance to the PrEP program. At any time, program requirements may be changed by state law/rule, the State Board for Educator Certification or program.

## Procedures for Application

- Complete Online Application
- Include three Reference Forms from Administrator/ Lead Teacher or Department Head/ Counselor or Teacher
- Secure an Acknowledgement from District HR or Counseling Administrator
- Submit official transcripts for all universities attended
- Complete an oral/written interview
