# Educational Diagnostician Program



## Eligibility Requirements

- Master's degree
- 3 years successful teaching experience
- Criminal history review

Meeting eligibility requirements does not guarantee an interview or acceptance to the PrEP program. At any time, program requirements may be changed by state law/rule, the State Board for Educator Certification or program.

## Procedures for Application

- Complete Application
- Include three Reference Forms from Administrator/ Teacher/ Educational Diagnostician
- Secure a Nomination from Special Education Director
- Submit official transcripts for all universities attended
- Complete an oral/written interview

## Pre-Service Coursework Requirements

Candidates must complete the following modules:

- Survey of Exceptional Children
- Methods and Strategies for Teaching Students with Special Needs
- Foundations of Reading Instruction
- Human Growth and Development
- Ethical Issues and Standards of Professional Practice
- Foundations of Measurements and Evaluations



- Specific Assessment Strategies for Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Students
- Evaluation of Students Early Childhood to Adult
- Laws, Regulations, Policies, and Communications
- Practicum/Diagnostician Internship

Transcripts demonstrating evidence of recently completed coursework may be substituted.
