Mike Lipkin

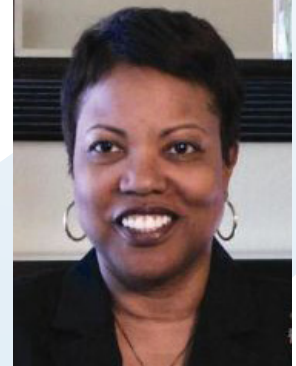
Mike Lipkin is president of Environics/Lipkin, the Motivation Company in the Environics Research Group, one of Canada's leading research houses.
