Family Math: Making Mathematics a Family Affair K-5

This session will help educators develop family math events with the use of the Family Math resource. The Family Math resource encourages hands-on math activities using materials found in many households. The session will focus on getting familiar with the resource, how to develop a timeline of events, and a plan for implementation. Participants will receive the Family Math resource book (one per campus). This session is reserved for educators or campuses who serve migrant students identified by Region 10 MEP.

Identification and Recruitment (ID&R) Training for Administrators

This session will provide information to districts in meeting compliance with state and federal Migrant Education Program laws, regulations, and guidelines. Administrators will receive information about current required documentation and dates for submitting information.

Identification and Recruitment (ID&R) Annual Training for Recruiters

Recruiters for districts throughout Region 10 will receive required annual ID&R training. Participants will receive a binder with current information for 2009-2010. This session is only for MEP Recruiters.

New Generation System Annual Training for NGS Specialists

NGS Specialists will receive required annual NGS training. Participants will receive the new 2009-2010 NGS manual. This session is only for NGS Specialists in the Region 10 area.
