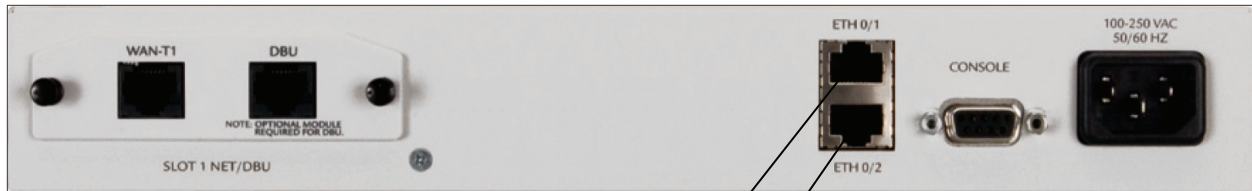

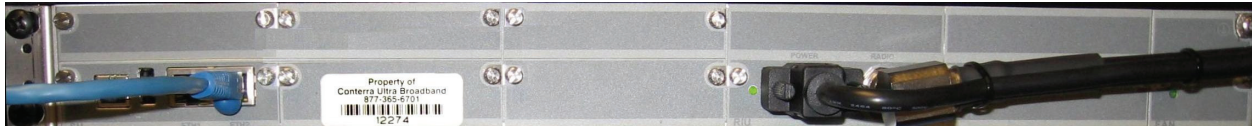


Connects to Conterra's microwave radio

The Wireless Internet Consortium represents 38 member school districts for wireless broadband Internet service. Region 10 will lead the consortium; act as fiscal agent; file for consortium E-rate discounts; provide oversight for network operation and manage layer three routing; provide training; request a CIPA Form 479 each year; request a Letter of Agency every 3 years; and invoice annually for the service.

Conterra Ultra Broadband provides 20 Mbps of dedicated Internet service to each member school district of the Wireless Internet Consortium. The carrier class network is designed to provide additional bandwidth in the future. Should you require additional bandwidth contact Gary Bowers by the end of the school year to discuss the request so it can be made available the next school year.
